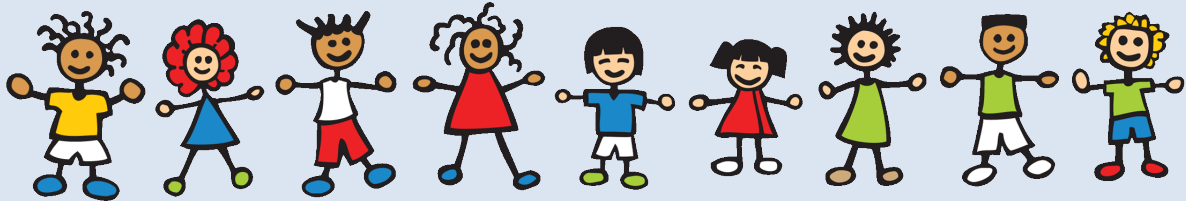

- Support the school's policies and guidance for behaviour
- Support the school's aims of celebrating the cultures of all the children who attend
- Ensure the school dress code is followed:
 - Navy blue or Black trousers/skirt
 - Light/Sky blue t-shirt or shirt
 - PE Kit – Black shorts or leggings and plain white T-shirt and suitable footwear for games indoors
 - PE Kit – Tracksuit bottoms or leggings with a jumper and suitable footwear for games indoors
- Talk to my child daily about their learning in school and praise effort
- Talk to my child about how they stay safe, both in the real world and online



Agreement for Children

To take responsibility for myself at school I will do my best to:

- Take good care for the school equipment and building
- Be friendly and polite to everyone in school
- Walk inside the school building
- Always tell the truth
- Always do my class work and homework as well as I can
- Come to school on time every day (except when I'm not well enough)
- Wear my uniform every day
- Speak to an adult if I need help with my learning or about any concerns or worries I might have in school or at home
- Use the internet at home or at school only under the supervision of an adult



Agreement for school staff

The school will do its best to:

- Take reasonable steps to ensure the safety, happiness and self confidence of all children
- Always listen to the child's/parent's/carer's point of view
- Provide a broad and balanced curriculum to meet the individual needs of your child
- Treat every child as an individual to achieve high standards of work and behaviours, so they can reach their full potential
- Inform parent/carer of their child's progress and of general school matters
- Provide an environment in which the child sees us as positive role models
- Celebrate diversity throughout the school, UK and the rest of the world
- Ensure discriminatory behaviour is not tolerated
- Contact parent/carers if there are any concerns about a child's progress or behaviour
