### 2018 Data Analysis and Commentary of EYFSP

2018 GLD was 56%, compared to 49% in 2017 and 53% in 2016.

#### On entry/exit Reception data

Reading = 22%\* entry at ARE. 56% achieved ARE+ leaving Reception.

Writing = 17%\* entry at ARE. 56% achieved ARE+ leaving Reception.

Number = 29%\* entry at ARE. 61% achieved ARE+ leaving Reception.

\*=66% of this cohort in Reading, 63% in Writing and 54% in Maths entered reception 'Well below' ARE.

ARE = Age Related Expectations

In the Early learning goals for Moving and Handling and Technology, this cohort out-performed

### 2018 Data Analysis and Commentary of Phonics

#### Year 1 Phonics

*This cohort's Good Level of Development was 49%.*

The school was very pleased by the Year 1 attainment and progress that reflected the hard work and effort of the children and staff in Year 1.

#### **Phonics**

- 87% of children reached the 'Expected standard' in Phonics.
  - Last year, HCPS achieved 83% of Y1 children meeting the standard in Phonics.
  - Nationally, 83% of children reached ES.
  - In Leeds, 79% of children reached ES.
- This represented a **23% increase** from this cohort's 64% achieving ARE in Reading at the end of Reception.



## 2018 Data Analysis and Commentary of Phonics

### Year 2 Phonics retest 2018

**52% of this cohort achieved the Expected Standard in Reading in EYFS.**

The school was very pleased by the Year 2 attainment and progress in the retest that reflected the hard work and effort of the children and staff in Year 2 and the interventions put in place.

#### Phonics

- 86% of children reached the 'Expected standard' in Phonics.
  - Nationally, 61% of children achieved ES in phonics.
  - In Leeds, 60% of children reached ES in Phonics.

### Year 1 and 2 Phonics test 2018

The school is very pleased by the combined result for both Year 1 and Year 2 attainment.

#### Phonics

- 96% of children reached the 'Expected standard' in Phonics in Years 1 and 2 combined.
  - Nationally, 92% of children reached ES in phonics by the end of KS1.
  - In Leeds, 89% of children reached ES in phonics by the end of KS1.

## 2018 Data Analysis and Commentary of KS1 SATs

***This cohort's Good Level of Development was 53% (National 69%)***

***This cohort's Phonic score was 83% (National 81%)***

The school was very pleased by the KS1 attainment and progress in 2018 that reflected the hard work and effort of the children and staff in KS1.

#### KS1 Reading

- 70% of children reached the 'Expected+ standard' in Reading.
  - Nationally, 75% of children reached ES.
  - In Leeds, 69% of children reached ES.
- 18% of children reached the 'Higher standard' in Reading.
  - Nationally, 26% of children reached HS.
  - In Leeds, 21% of children reached HS.

***At EYFS, this cohort achieved 52% 'Expected+ in Reading with 15% exceeding. Our latest KS1 data represents a 18% increase from this cohort's EYFS assessment at Expected+ and a 3% increase at the higher standard.***



## **2018 Data Analysis and Commentary of KS1 SATs**

### **KS1 Writing**

- 64% of children reached the 'Expected+ standard' in Writing.
  - Nationally, 70% of children reached ES.
  - In Leeds, 63% of children reached ES.
- 11% of children reached the 'Higher standard' in Writing.
  - Nationally, 16% of children reached HS.
  - In Leeds, 12% of children reached HS.

***At EYFS, this cohort achieved 52% 'Expected+ in Writing with 5% exceeding. Our KS1 data therefore represents a 12% increase from this cohort's EYFS assessment at Expected+ and a 6% increase at the higher standard.***

### **KS1 Maths**

- 75% of children reached the 'Expected+ standard' in Maths.
  - Nationally, 76% of children reached ES.
  - In Leeds, 71% of children reached ES.
- 18% of children reached the 'Higher standard' in Maths.
  - Nationally, 22% of children reached HS.
  - In Leeds, 17% of children reached HS.

***At EYFS, this cohort achieved 64% 'Expected+ in Number with 5% exceeding. Our KS1 data therefore represents a 11% increase from this cohort's EYFS assessment at Expected+ and a 13% increase at the higher standard.***

### **KS1 Reading, Writing and Maths combined**

- 64% of children reached the 'Expected+ standard' in all three subjects.
  - Nationally, 65% of children reached ES in all three subjects.
  - In Leeds, 58% of children reached ES in all three subjects.
- 7% of children reached the 'Higher standard' in all three subjects.
  - Nationally, 12% of children reached the HS in all three subjects.
  - In Leeds, 8% of children reached the HS in all three subjects.

***Our 2018 KS1 R/W/M Combined scores show a 3-year trend of above local RWM data and at least in line with National KS1 RWM data.***



## **2018 Data Analysis and Commentary of KS2 SATs**

### **KS2 Reading**

- 56.3% of children reached the 'Expected standard' in Reading.
  - Nationally, 75% of children reached ES
  - In Leeds, 71% of children reached ES
- 8% of children reached the 'Higher standard' in Reading.
  - Nationally, 28% of children reached HS
  - In Leeds, 26% of children reached HS
- The school's average scaled score was 100.4.
  - Nationally, the average scaled score was 105.1
  - In Leeds, the average scaled score was 104.3
- The school achieved a progress measure of -3.1 (-4.9 to -1.3)

***Highest attainment score for Exp+ in Reading over the past 3 years, and increase of 12% from 2017 results.***

***The first time the school has achieved over '100' as a scaled score.  
100 = Expected Standard.***

### **KS2 Writing**

- 65% of children reached the 'Expected standard' in Writing.
  - Nationally, 78% of children reached ES
  - In Leeds, 73% of children reached ES
- 2% of children reached the 'Higher standard' in Writing.
  - Nationally, 20% of children reached HS
  - In Leeds, 17% of children reached HS
- The school achieved a progress measure of -3.1 (-4.9 to -1.3)

***Increased attainment of 3% from 2017 writing results.***

### **KS2 Maths**

- 67% of children reached the 'Expected standard' in Maths.
  - Nationally, 76% of children reached ES.
  - In Leeds, 71% of children reached ES.
- 15% of children reached the 'Higher standard' in Maths.
  - Nationally, 24% of children reached HS.
  - In Leeds, 22% of children reached HS.
- The school's average scaled score was 101.5.
  - Nationally, the average scaled score was 104.4
  - In Leeds, the average scaled Score was 103.7
- The school achieved a progress measure of -1.5 (-3.2 to 0.2)

***The 6% increase on 2017 data, continues to show a positive 3-year upwards trend in Maths attainment at KS2.***



## 2018 Data Analysis and Commentary of KS2 SATs

### KS2 GPS (Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling)

- 67% of children reached the 'Expected standard' in GPS.
  - Nationally, 78% of children reached ES
  - In Leeds, 74% of children reached ES
- 21% of children reached the 'Higher standard' in GPS.
  - Nationally, 34% of children reached HS
  - In Leeds, 32% of children reached HS
- The school's average scaled score was 103.
  - Nationally, the average scaled score was 106.
  - In Leeds, the average scaled score was 105.

***Our 2018 GPS data show an increase of 10% in attainment at Expected + standard and a 9% increase at the higher standards, from 2017 data.***

### KS2 Reading, Writing and Maths Combined

- 48% of children reached the 'Expected standard' in all three subjects.
  - Nationally, 65% of children reached ES in all three subjects.
  - In Leeds, 60% of children reached ES in all three subjects.
- 2% of children reached the 'Higher standard' in all three subjects.
  - Nationally, 10% of children reached the HS in all three subjects.
  - In Leeds, 9% of children reached the HS in all three subjects.

***10% increase for children achieving 'Expected' standard in R/W/M combined, compared to 2017 data.***
