



For the financial year 2017 – 18, Hunslet Carr will receive **£19,380** in Sport Premium. The planned expenditure for this funding allocation is as follows:

Service Level Agreement with Active Schools- £1,000

The school will continue to sign up to the Active Schools service level agreement. It will allow us to continue to access professional advice and support to further develop the provision we provide for Physical Education, school sport and physical activity. The SLA allows us to access CPD and a wide range of school sport competitions and events.

Service Level Agreement with TSLA - £1,000

The school is wanting to continue links with the local high school and schools in the local cluster. Therefore, we are planning to sign up to a SLA once again. Schools within the cluster can compete in more competitions and have access to a wider range of sports via taster days.

Teaching Resources - £1,500

We will continue update our teaching resources for Real PE to ensure that staff and pupils have access to the most up to date and effective resources to support learning and progress.

Coaching - £5,075

To increase the amount of physical activity and range of activities available to all children during lunchtimes, we will be employing coaches from the local Hunslet Boys Club. The coaches will work alongside lunchtime staff, supporting their own delivery of lunchtime activities. These links will also encourage children to join



their extra-curricular clubs. To improve school sport, the Hunslet Club will be running after school clubs.

Kit - £500

To continue to promote the importance of PE kit, we will be purchasing polo shirts for members of staff new to the school to ensure that they are modelling correct kit in PE lessons.

CPD - £750

Two members of staff will be sent on 3 day Real PE training to increase their expertise and allow them to support other staff with the effective teaching of PE.

Other staff will have the opportunity to access this training if necessary later in the year,

- Real Play delivery - £1,365

In order to increase physical activity and involve parents and carers in maintaining a healthy lifestyle, we are investing in 'Real Play'. We will send a member of staff on training, who will then deliver play based physical activity sessions to parents and children. Each family will receive a pack to take home, which will enable them to continue physical activity.

Kit - £2,000

In order to raise the profile of sports teams in school and out of school, we will purchase new kits to be worn by all school sports teams at competitions and matches. It will make our children recognisable and gave them an identity when they are representing school.



Staff - £1,000

To ensure that children are able to access a wide range of competitive sporting events after school, we will employ a member of staff to drive to all events.

Equipment - £3000

New equipment will need to be purchased to replenish stocks and to complement the new scheme of work to allow lessons to run effectively.

We have also identified that we need to replace the gymnastics mats in order to ensure that they meet the correct health and safety standards.

£498.98 of the above will be spent on specific Real PE bags, which contain everything for a lesson.

Swimming - £2,190

To ensure that all children in Year 6 leave our school with at least the minimum swimming requirement, we will investigate investing in additional swimming either before or after the designated swimming lessons in Year 4.
