



For the financial year 2016 – 17, Hunslet Carr received **£9515** in Sport Premium. The expenditure for this funding allocation is as follows:

Service Level Agreement with Active Schools- £1,000

The school continued to sign up to the Active Schools service level agreement. It allowed us to continue to access professional advice and support to further develop the provision we provided for Physical Education, school sport and physical activity. The SLA allowed us to access CPD and a wider range of school sport competitions and events.

Service Level Agreement with TSLA - £1,000

The school wanted to improve links with the local high school and schools in the local cluster. Therefore, we signed up to a SLA created by The South Leeds Academy, where schools within the cluster competed in more competitions and had access to a wider range of sports via taster days.

Teaching Resources - £960

We continued to update teaching resources to support the effective teaching of Physical Education. We had planned to purchase new gymnastics teaching resources in preparation for the introduction of our new scheme 'Real Gym'. However, in response to observing PE lessons and there being a number of new members of staff in school, it was decided that we would focus on embedding Real PE.

We continued our membership with iMoves dance, to allow teachers to access high quality dance lesson plans.



Coaching - £1,000

After the sustained success of employing a gymnastics coach, we continued to use the funding to pay for specialist after school gymnastics clubs. Clubs continued to be fully subscribed. The clubs were offered to children in all year groups, of all abilities.

Kit - £500

To continue to promote the importance of PE kit, we purchased replacement polo shirts for members of staff and for staff new to the school to ensure that they modelled correct kit in PE lessons.

CPD - £2,320

We purchased a whole staff CPD training for Real Gym, but decided that this would be postponed until the following year when Real PE was properly embedded. The money spent was transferred to CPD on Real PE for this year and the next school year.

All staff received a full day training session to improve confidence and competence in teaching PE.



Staff - £1,000

To ensure that children are able to access a wide range of competitive sporting events after school, we employed a member of staff to drive to all events.

Equipment - £1500

New equipment was purchased to replenish stocks and to resource the School Sports Day.
