#### Note from Leeds City Council

## PLEASE NOTE IMPORTANT CHANGES

If you are happy with your accepted offer you <u>must</u> advise Leeds City Council admissions to remove your child from waiting lists for other schools you requested with a higher preference to ensure your school place does not change.

## If your child did not get a place at the school you wanted for September 2024.

If your child did not qualify for a place at any of your preferred schools, they will be offered a place at their closest school with available places and remain on the waiting list for your higher preferences unless you advise Leeds City Council admissions to remove them. If a place becomes available, unless you have removed your child from the waiting list, your child's school place will change to the higher preference and the original offer will be withdrawn, even if you have accepted the offer. Therefore, if you are happy with your offer, you must accept it with the school and advise Leeds City Council admissions that you wish to be removed from other waiting lists.

You also have the option to:

- check which primary schools still have places.
- join a waiting list for other schools you haven't previously asked for.

make an appeal.

To ensure your child has a place for September 2024, you should accept your offer even if you decide to stay on a waiting list or appeal (this will not affect either process).

If you are considering **refusing the offer**, please be aware of the following information from Leeds City Council:

- · if you turn down a place, it will be allocated to another child and we cannot guarantee a place will become available at a closer school to home they could be left without a Reception place in September
- · understand accepting an offer doesn't impact the chances of being offered a place from the waiting list or increase the chances of success at an appeal hearing
- any family who refuses an offer must confirm this in writing to <u>startingprimary@leeds.gov.uk</u> and confirm where you will be educating your child in September.
